The Welsh in Southwest Wisconsin. Sat., September 28, Pendarvis Ed. Center. Spruce St., Free: Welsh-born historian Robert Humphries will speak about the immigration of farmers and miners from Wales to SW WI beginning in the 1840s. The Welsh settled throughout Iowa County and many became prosperous and prominent citizens in their communities. They also carried with them from Wales a distinctive culture expressed in their Celtic language. Humphries will discuss the history of the Welsh from their arrival to their cultural and linguistic assimilation in the early 20th century.
